DREAM TOOLS

Dreams are an endless source of inspiration, encounter with God, healing, direction, warning, refreshing, etc... Since there are so many different types of dreams that affect us in so many different ways I'd like to present you with some tools that will help you figure out what type of dream you are having, and what God may be saying to you through it.

Emotions in a dream are probably one of the most overlooked aspects of dream work. If you spend any amount of time working on your dreams, you will spend a lot of time asking questions about the symbols in the dream. But what about the emotions you feel in the dream? Often God will give a dream or a vision that will cause an intense reaction in the dreamer. Peter's vision in Acts 10 is a good example. Peter's response to the vision was, "Surely not Lord! I have never eaten anything unclean in all my life!" Why such a strong emotional reaction? Because God was trying to push Peter's buttons to show Peter his judgments, vows, and where his culture controlled him more than the Spirit of God. This vision started a series of events that led to Peter being able to throw off these vows and cultural controls.

In fact, emotions in dreams will often be connected to something that you are currently experiencing. This is not true of prophetic dreams as those events haven't happened yet, but most prophetic people will tell you that 85-90% of your dreams are for, or about you...so there is a good chance the emotions in your dream will connect to your life a good part of the time. If you want to 'connect' your dream to what area in your life the dream may be about, take a look at the emotions in the dream. Are you currently experiencing those dream emotions anywhere in your life. In the dream the emotions may be huge, in life not so much, God often amplifies dream emotions to put a magnifying glass on something he wants us to pay attention to.

Go through the feelings in the dream and ask yourself and Jesus some questions concerning them: Do I feel like this anywhere in my life? Jesus where do you see this emotion in my life?

Often, once you connect the dream to what area of life God is speaking into the rest of the interpretation will fall into place and since the emotions in dreams are often more literal than the images, it's a good place to start.

Final reminder: jot some notes in your journal before bed to keep a record of how you felt and what you did during the day. This will help you become more in touch with your feelings and help you connect your dreams better!
